NACN-USA Nursing Awards

The National Association of Catholic Nurses-USA offers a \$1000. award each year to a student nurse midway through the clinical portion of his/her nursing program

Criteria

The name of the award applicant shall be forwarded by an active member or a school of nursing.

Applicants will show need for financial assistance by writing a 500 word essay.

The applicant must submit documentation showing a grade point average of 3.0 for an undergraduate and 3.5 for a graduate student based on a 4.0 score.

Relevant activities pertaining to professional nursing, leadership abilities, nursing scholarship and service shall be documented by 3 faculty members of their school of nursing and a letter from their pastor documenting good standing in their parish.

Award applications shall be postmarked no later than March 30 of each year.

Procedure for granting Award

The award applications shall be postmarked no later than March 30 of each year.

The chairman of the award committee will forward the applications to the committee members within 2 weeks.

The awards chairman will interview the applicants in person or by telephone.

The applicants approved by the committee will be forwarded to the President and the Board of directors by May 1.

Awardees will be notified by the committee chairperson by June 1 and will be asked to be the student Representative on the Board of Directors.

Checks will be made out to their school of nursing and be mailed before August 1.
